COVID-compliance agreement, CMA members and parents

CMA has worked closely with the Royal Grammar School and Wycombe High School to make sure our community is as safe as possible with regard to COVID-19. Our [Risk Assessment](#) can be found on our website and should be read in conjunction with our general [Health and Safety Policy](#).

We are following the latest government guidelines for performing arts and must ask all parents and members to confirm that they will comply with the following when resuming activities:

- Keep socially distanced at 2 metres or an absolute minimum of one metre at all times.
- Come on site only if you are signed up to take part in a specific ensemble, unless you are a parent/carer of Micro Springers or Mini Springers. Parents can still use the school car parks as usual.
- Arrive no more than ten minutes before a rehearsal and leave no more than ten minutes afterwards.
- Arrive no more than ten minutes before a rehearsal and leave no more than ten minutes afterwards.
- Please wear a face mask to enter all buildings and keep it on until settled in your designated rehearsal place and the rehearsal is just about to begin. Replace it at the end of the rehearsal and keep it on until leaving the premises. (As per government guidelines, people with relevant medical conditions and children under the age of eleven do not need to comply.)
- Students may not wait inside between activities.
- Follow the one way systems.
- Use hand sanitizer provided on entry to buildings.
- Band and orchestral players should bring a music stand and a pencil! Everyone will be using their own, with individual music.
- Do not share any instruments or other equipment.
- Brass and Woodwind players should bring a plastic bag with tissues to collect any condensate. Cleaning of these instruments must take place at home, or outside in an emergency.
- Keep smaller instrument cases and personal belongings under your chair.
- There will be no Tuck Shop so you may wish to bring a drink. Please keep personal belongings to a minimum and always with you.
- Understand that CMA will be keeping seating plans and attendance records of every session to support NHS Track and Trace requests and to determine whether advice needs to be given to other participants.

- If anyone has symptoms of COVID-19 they will not attend CMA until a negative test is confirmed.
- If anyone has a positive COVID-19 test they will follow government guidelines and inform CMA as soon as possible.
- If a student exhibits symptoms during a session, they will be isolated until they can be collected by a parent or carer.
