

Covid-19 Compliance agreement, January 2022

CMA has worked closely with the Royal Grammar School and Wycombe High School to make sure our community is as safe as possible with regard to covid-19. Our [Risk Assessment](#) can be found on our website and should be read in conjunction with our general [Health and Safety Policy](#).

We are following the latest government guidelines for performing arts and must ask all parents and members to confirm that they will comply with the following when resuming activities:

- If anyone has symptoms of Covid-19 they will not attend CMA until a clear test is confirmed.
- We request that, where possible, all attendees carry out an LFD test before attending a CMA session.
- Please retain social distancing, being mindful that Covid-19 is still present in the community.
- Those over the age of eleven (including parents), unless exempt, must wear masks when entering and leaving buildings or moving about from room to room to minimise potential transmission. Masks should be kept on until seated in the rehearsal space and put back on as soon as the rehearsal has ended.
- We strongly encourage masks to be worn by those over age eleven when playing if possible, ie string and percussion players, unless exempt. Singers are welcome to wear a mask if they wish
- Parents and carers are welcome to come on site as necessary, and Tuck Shop will be open. Please ensure that you follow the same LFD testing, mask and social distancing guidance as for the children.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided on entry to buildings and we encourage all to continue sanitising their hands on arrival.
- Please bring a music stand and pencil if playing a musical instrument in an ensemble. Everyone will continue to use their own stand and music at the start of term. We will review the return to sharing music stands on a regular basis so that CMA ensembles remain in line with general current practice.
- Understand that CMA will be keeping seating plans and attendance records of every session to support NHS Track and Trace requests if necessary and to determine whether advice needs to be given to other participants.
- If anyone has a positive Covid-19 test they will follow government guidelines and inform CMA as soon as possible.
- If a student exhibits symptoms during a session they will be isolated until they can be collected by a parent or carer.
